

Gingivitis (Gum Disease)

Gingivitis is an early stage of gum disease with symptoms that include bleeding gums, persistent bad breath, and swollen, red or tender gums. At the root of the disease is an infection that causes inflammation. Early treatment can prevent this infection from spreading, reverse it, and prevent its reoccurrence.

Chronic, low grade infection in the mouth has been linked to arterial inflammation, type 2 diabetes, heart attack, stroke, pregnancy complications, dementia, and certain types of cancers. Like any disease, early intervention is best. Your Doctor and Hygienist have recommended this therapy program to treat your condition.
